REGULATORY CHANGES HOS, AB5, RANDOM RATES, ELD, AND MORE



HOURS OF SERVICE QUICK HITS

• Short Haul Exemption:

Expanding current 100 air-mile exemption from 12 hrs on-duty to 14 hrs on-duty, to be consistent with 150 air-mile exemption

Adverse Driving Conditions:

Extending by 2 hours the max window which driving is permitted, currently 14-hour on-duty limitation

• 30 Minute Rest Break:

Increase flexibility by tying break requirement to 8 hrs of driving time without an interruption for at least 30 minutes, and allowing the break by using on duty, not driving status, rather than off duty


Sleeper Berth:

Allow drivers to split required 10-hours off duty into two periods: 8 and 2 split or 7 and 3 split, either off duty or in the sleeper berth.

OOIDA Petition:

Allow up to 3 hours off duty that would extend the 14 hour window


HOS: WHEN WILL WE KNOW?

ENTRY LEVEL DRIVER TRAINING RULE

- Compliance Date: Was Feb 7th, 2020... Just been delayed for Feb 7th, 2022
- For fleets to provide training to entry-level drivers, they must be in the registry and comply with the rule's required curriculum.
- Delay is needed to further build out the needed IT infrastructure



INSURANCE RATES SKYROCKETING QUICK HITS

 Recent "nuclear verdicts" in cases involving CMV accidents with distracted driving make clear that juries will not just hold the driver accountable, but the motor carrier as well.
